CERTIFICATE OF CLEARANCE INSTRUCTIONS

You need either a Certificate of Clearance OR a valid Emergency Teaching Permit to be admitted to SDSU's Credential Program. Certificates of Clearance documents are valid for **five years**.

When your clearance is issued, you will be *notified via email* and the *CCTC website will note the issuance of Certificate of Clearance*. You may download a copy of the website information for your records. The normal processing time for the certificate of clearance is approximately 10 business days.

If your application must be reviewed by the Commission's Division of Professional Practice, the process will take longer. The online file will indicate that the application in *pending additional evaluation*. 30 DAYS SUBSTITUTE PERMIT

The Emergency Teaching Permit allows a candidate to seek for employment as a substitute teacher in any public school district. The permit once issued is valid for one year and must be valid while you are enrolled in the credential program.

Application Requirements:

- To qualify for the 30 Days Substitute permit, you must have a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university. Official transcripts showing the conferral of your degree is required.
- The candidate must also meet Basic Skills requirements (CBEST). A copy of the exam is acceptable.

The San Diego County Office of Education will verify your eligibility and process your 30 Days Substitute Permit via the CTC's online recommendation system. Please note in addition to the fingerprint fees above, a separate document fee of \$100.00 is required for the CCTC online application.

When your emergency substitute permit is issued, you will be notified via email and your document will be posted at the CTC website. You can print a copy of the document for your records.
